We completed the first phase (liquid processing) of our newest expansion and have completed plans for the second phase (packaging). The first phase is a state of the art facility that has a control room and is entirely contained, with sealed flooring. All of our liquid processing will soon be performed in this new 12,500 square foot addition. The new packaging facility, expected completion next spring, will be adjoined to this building and will add an additional 10,500 square feet allowing streamlined processing and packaging.
