Shipping Clerk

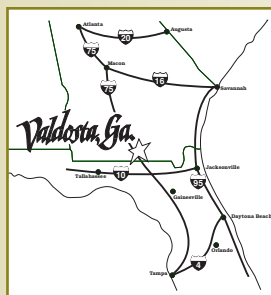
